

A New Model for Skilled Nursing

The Evergreen Villas are part of The Green House Project[®] a revolutionary national model for skilled nursing care that puts home, belonging, and a sense of independence at the heart of each resident's daily living experience. Mt. San Antonio Gardens pioneered the concept in California in 2013, further expanding the continuum of care we offer on our 31-acre campus. The Villas' inviting home environment and innovative staffing model encourage social interaction and provide residents the freedom to live life on their own schedule.



A Real Home

There's a certain peace that home brings. The Evergreen

Villas' two light-filled Craftsmen-style homes capture a sense of serenity and belonging for each Villa's 10 residents. The architecturally distinctive design and exquisite details further enhance the comfort and pleasure of spending time in your own private room, with en-suite bathroom, and enjoying the spacious, welcoming indoor and outdoor living areas. Meals are prepared in the home's open kitchen – residents are welcome to help or share a favorite recipe – and can either enjoy each meal family-style with others or on their own.



A Meaningful Life

Residents at the Evergreen Villas enjoy the freedom and independence to pursue the interests and activities that they enjoy most – on their own schedules – with the full support of their care partners and the companionship of their fellow residents. There's always someone to talk to, someone to joke with, or a quiet corner for solitary pursuits. Residents are empowered to do more for themselves, which reinforces the sense of home and independence and enriches conversations around the dinner table, when the household gathers to share a meal and the day's activities. It feels like family.



An Empowered Staff

At the heart of each home is a small, self-managed team of care partners – Licensed Nurses and Certified Nursing Assistants – whose goal is to encourage the residents' independence and foster their ability to pursue their interests. Together, they manage the household and provide daily care and companionship to residents. As part of the Villa's "family," they learn the residents' life stories, discover their interests and understand their abilities and needs. That familiarity allows them to recognize subtle changes and provide insights to the clinical support team.
