


OAK TREE LODGE



AMENITIES

Residents of Oak Tree Lodge enjoy unlimited access to the Gardens' amenities, including the Wellness Center with its exercise facilities and full program of classes, putting green, beautifully appointed Social Center, 6000-volume library, salon and barber services, gift shop, rose garden and cutting garden.

At the Lodge, laundry facilities, community rooms and private lounges with kitchenettes are readily available to residents. Convenient transportation is provided for medical and dental appointments and shopping. Special services, such as massage therapy, personal laundry service and private catering, are available for a fee.



CARE

Residents of Oak Tree Lodge receive the individual attention of caregivers who collaborate with family members and personal physicians to provide supportive care.

At Oak Tree Lodge, assistance with daily needs are included in one monthly fee so there are no surprises.

These include:

- Accommodations with 24-hour assistance and emergency call lights
- Three meals each day
- Linen service
- Housekeeping service
- Utilities (except phone and cable TV)
- Assistance with activities of daily living (bathing, dressing, and personal hygiene)
- Evaluation of health status and contacts with personal physicians and family
